

The Requirements of the Major in East Asian Languages and Literatures (Chinese Track/Japanese Track)

Group A: Literature-in-translation courses (including courses on theater and film taught in English) with numbers EALL 200s and 300s.

Group B: Advanced courses with readings in Chinese and/or Japanese, literary (classical) or modern.

Note: all language courses in EALL through the two terms of courses in literary Chinese and Japanese have CHNS, JAPN or KREN prefixes; all other courses have EALL prefixes.

Some of the requirements listed here may be fulfilled through courses taken for credit and passed in programs of study abroad, with appropriate documentation and the approval of the DUS. A maximum of one course taken Credit/D/Fail at Yale may be counted toward the requirements of the major with permission of the DUS.
